Dates, Schedule and Venue

The competition will be organized in the **Ruutikangas Shooting Center**, [Ruutikankaantie 15](#), 91900 Liminka (FIN) 11.-22.8.2025 (E64.773845, N25.222351).

- Official arrivals 11.8.2025
- Training 12.8.2025
- Technical meeting 12.8.2025
- Competitions 13.-21.8.2025
- Official departure 22.8.2025

The preliminary schedule is attached. Please note there may be changes to the timetable once entries have been closed. The final schedule will be available in the competition webpage after the final entry's deadline.

Shooting in silhouette disciplines will take place in 100 m and 600 m ranges.

Simultaneously with the silhouette competitions ERABSF European Benchrest Championships and World Cup will be organised during 6.-16.8.2025 by the same organising committee.

Competition rules

The European Championship will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the international federations.

Tie-breakings will be managed according to the General Technical Rules. Shoot-offs will only be organised for ranks 1, 2 and 3 in individual categories to govern the championships schedule (and help the streaming of the events). For other ties the reverse animal count will be used.

Juries will be nominated by the championships director to supervise the championships.

The events will be organised according to the standing rules of the IMSSU.

For juniors (20 years) following aggregates are organised

- Four Match Small Bore Pistol Aggregate (Production; Revolver; Standing and Unlimited)
- Two Match Small Bore Rifle Aggregate (Light and Silhouette)
- no junior categories in classes or grades.

The world cup competitions will be organised only in those disciplines in which there are participants outside of the European championships.

Participation of the Member Federations

No restrictions for the number of participants of member federations will be set before the entry-by-number (preliminary entry) deadline.

All Member Federation are recommended to wear their national identification on their shooting clothing. This could be a flag or 3 letter abbreviation of their country.

All participating countries must check the situation concerning movement to Finland and AETSM decisions before starting any entry procedure. Further information can be found in the webpage of the Ministry for the Foreign Affairs of Finland (MFAF). [Visit the webpages of the MFAF.](#)

Entry process, Payments and Accreditation

Member Federations participating in the championships must submit their Preliminary Entries (entry-by-numbers) not later than January 31st, 2025; here you can find the **preliminary entry form**.

If necessary, the AETSM and the IMSSU will allocate the number of participants from each country according to Preliminary Entries and the range resources to guarantee a fair treatment of all member federations. This will be announced by the Local Organising Committee (LOC) well before the final entry (entry-by-names) deadline.

Final entry registration (entry-by-names) must be made by ECH2025 entry form not later than April 30th, 2025. The entry form will be published on ECH2025.fi (Registration). All other forms (Visa Support Form, Firearms and Ammunition Form, Final Travel Form, Media Accreditation Form etc) will also be published in the official webpage.

The participating federation must pay all entry fees and requested services according to the final entry form to the Finnish Shooting Sport Federation through a bank transfer.

All bank transfers must be made in EUR and must include any fees the bank may charge. Please take care that all necessary data are indicated, so that the LOC can assign payments to the correct federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer slip to your Team Leader to bring it as a proof of payment for the accreditation office.

Exceptionally, on-the-site payments can be made through contactless payments systems (credit or debit cards).

An entry fees for the European championship and World Cup include the registration and one discipline payment. Aggregates are free-of-charge. Other payments are on demands of the participant.

Hotel and rental car service (etc) payments must be done to the service provider.

The accreditation for all participants, officials will take place at the Ruutikangas Shooting Center. Accreditations will be distributed after full payment of the entry fees and other costs to the LOC. All team leaders are required to report to the Accreditation and Payment Office and confirm their Final Entries. This confirmation must take place latest 12:00 (noon) on the day before the specific competition. Replacement of a registered athlete by another athlete for the championship is permitted. This change can only be made latest 12:00 (noon) on the day before the specific competition.

Any Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and/or officials after the final entry deadline is obliged to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of entries in the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Visa

Participants of the EU or Schengen country does not need a visa when travelling to Finland.

National federations are responsible for obtaining a visa if necessary. They can find information about visas between Finland and other countries here: <https://um.fi/visa-to-visit-finland>. For those who need an invitation letter for visa, the LOC will provide an invitation letter by request. Provide the LOC with names and passport numbers.

Import and Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

The travelling with a Nordic Firearm Permit or a European Firearm Pass does not need a special Finnish permit when entering in Finland with firearms and ammunitions. Athletes without those permits must apply a temporary firearm permit with Finnish Police Application Forms 10 and 10a (<https://poliisi.fi/lomakkeet>) and emailed to luvat oulu@poliisi.fi and LOC@ech2025.fi not depending when and where you are entering Finland for the championships. Applications should be prepared for every single travel group by the group leader (not for every athlete in the group). Team leaders or separate groups must possess the championships invitation letter (this letter) and their national firearm permits with them. The LOC will assist participants to get permissions for their firearms and ammunition if requested.

In Finland an athlete does not need a firearm license for an air rifle/pistol in calibre less than 6.35 mm.

Contact your airliner about the regulations for transporting firearms and ammunition.

The firearm and ammunition storage service will be opened 30.7.2025. The storage service will be open limited hours before the official arrival day. The storage service will also be open until 22.8.2025. An air filling service will be provided besides the storage service.

The firearm and ammunition storage service will be organised for those coming prior to the event. During the event firearms and ammunitions will be possessed by the teams. Firearms can be kept in your accommodation (etc) during your stay in Finland. The firearm and ammunition storage service will be available 30.7-22.8.2025.

Arrivals and Transportations

The nearest international airport is about 15 kilometer from the city of Oulu and about 35 kilometer from the Shooting Center Ruutikangas. The main air carrier to Oulu is Finnair being a member of the OneWorld Airlines which have six flights daily (August 2024) from the Helsinki airport. The Helsinki international airport is the main hub in Finland where all the major international air carriers operate.

Depending on the flight business situation you may find a direct flight also from Munich (GER) and Riga (LAT) to Oulu. Optionally you can fly to Rovaniemi (FIN), which is about 250 km north from Oulu, to sense the atmosphere of Finnish Lapland. Oulu region may be reached quite easily also via Sweden. The city of Luleå has its own airport from which it is 270 km drive to Oulu region. Furthermore, all the road network of Norway and Sweden can be utilized to entry Finland. The border control is located between the cities of Haparanda (SWE) and Tornio (FIN).

The LOC will provide assistant service in the Oulu airport on official arrival and departure days. The LOC will arrange transportation service from/to airport Oulu to official championship hotels and between the official hotels to the shooting range for those who have requested it. The transport service will be at extra costs.

The LOC proposes that Hertz (www.hertz.fi) car rental system will be used in Finland. Find the service [here](#). Use the promo code (CDP) 943008. The reservations are requested to be done early enough to organise needed vehicles.

Hotels and Meals

All teams has to organise accommodations by their own during the competitions. The LOC proposes that pre-reserved hotels (3 - 4 stars) will be used. Hotels are situated 5 – 35 km from venues.

Meals

On the shooting range there will be a restaurant where warm meals and snacks can be purchased. The tap water in Finland is potable.

Technical meeting and Ceremonies

The technical meeting will be organised 12.8.2025 (TBD) in the shooting range area.

Each participating Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition Schedule, draw procedures and other important issues related to the European Championships and World Cup.

Ceremonies

- a brief opening ceremony in the shooting range will be held 12.12.2025

- closing dinner and prize giving ceremony 21.8.2025

All participating countries are requested to provide a national flag (approximately 1 x 1,5 m²) and a short (max 60 sec) version of the national anthem in a memory stick to be presented for winners in the award ceremonies.

The closing dinner will be with an extra fee.

Anti-Doping

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the World Antidoping Agency (WADA) Rules by the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports ([FINCIS](#)).

Medical Services and Insurances

The LOC will provide a first-aid station in the shooting range area. It will also guide participants for further care if necessary. In the Oulu region there is good public and private health care.

Each member federation and/or participants is responsible for the appropriate insurances for accidents, health and property of their team. The LOC is not liable for any cases.

Information service and media

Should someone plan to purchase a Finnish mobile phone subscription, [Elisa](#) is recommended for tested coverage.

All media representatives of the participating countries will be invited through the ERABSF, WRABF or their member federations. Before attending the championship, all media representatives must register by sending the relevant personal (name, AIPS id, contact info etc), media (TV, radio, magazine, photo, journalist) and travel information to the LOC (loc@ech2025.fi) according to the deadline for entry by names. For visa and other local services needed, follow the instructions for athletes.

AETSM annual general meeting (AGM)

AETMS annual general meeting will be organised in the Scandic Oulu City in 19.8.2025 (TBD).

Relevant Weather Information

The temperature in the Oulu region in August is approximately between 14 – 18 °C. The sun rises in August about 5:00 o'clock and goes down at about 22:00 which makes the daylight as long as 17 hours a day. The average number of rainy days is 12.
